Minute 1: Preliminaries

The meeting started at 10:00a.m. by a word of prayer from one of the client representative. The procurement focal person called the meeting to order and requested all bidders that were present to register, introduction of the members was done, and thereafter he gave a brief overview on the purpose of the meeting.

Minute 2: Clarification of project technicalities. RFITT manager explained the technical expectation of the project, in terms of electricity supply, power demand for the three blocks

(factory, administration block, and hostels), and distribution plan of the same. The transformer

rating was given at 1MVA de-rated to 789KVA.

Minute 3: Bidding Process

Procurement focal person explained the process, the timelines and the importance of the site visit,

And ensuring relevant documents attached are authentic, abiding by the Instruction to Bidders as

per the Tender documents.

Minute 4: Site visits

Clients and bidders members visited the site, and did the survey: Bidders were taken through the

power house, shown the transformer, generator, and boiler rooms respectively. Then power line

cable sleeves were identified and shown to all bidders. Positioning of main LV board, sub-boards

(Panels) of all blocks were explained and shown. Bidders also surveyed the distance from the main

power supply (transformer) to the respective power points at the factory, administration and hostels

blocks.

Any queries and concerns were handled accordingly.

Minute 5: Way forward

The bidders still had one week to provide their bid documents, and they were given confirmation

that the Kisumu national polytechnic procurement processes are open, transparent, with above
